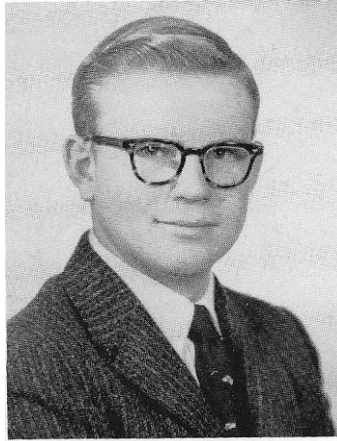
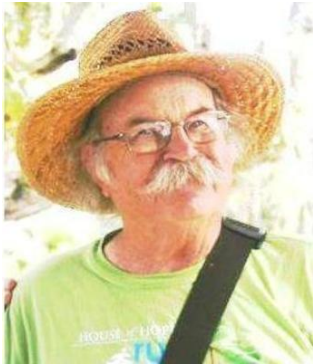

Dr. Albert Carl Nelson passed away after a short illness on February 27th 2014 at the Winter Park Memorial Hospital. He was born in Norwich, NY on April 23, 1943, the son of Walter L. and Rae W. (Ledford) Nelson. Growing up in Ithaca, he attended elementary school in Cayuga Heights and graduated from Ithaca High School in 1961. Following his graduation from Cornell University (BS, 1965) and MIT (PhD, 1970), he pursued post-doctoral studies with two years each at the University of Southampton, England, and then at the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia. He then worked for 35 years doing applied research in the fields of physical chemistry and electronics, taking him first to Georgia Tech Research Institute in Atlanta, Metric Systems in Ft. Walton Beach, Florida, and finally Lockheed-Martin in Orlando, from which he recently retired. Among his many talents, he liked to observe that he was a "world expert" in Russian radar systems. He leaves his two sons and daughter-in-law, Paul S. Nelson of Boston and Eric S. and Sara Nelson of Augusta, Georgia, granddaughter Brooke and brother Peter O. Nelson of Corvallis, Oregon and sister Linnea Nelson Clark of Pepperell, MA. He was a proud father and grandfather and had a soft touch with wayward cats. He was a dedicated "hasher", most recently with The Other Orlando Hash House Harriers and will forever be Lost Puppy to his many friends. But most of all, Dr. Al was a lifelong engineer and researcher. He strived to know it all, and nearly did!
