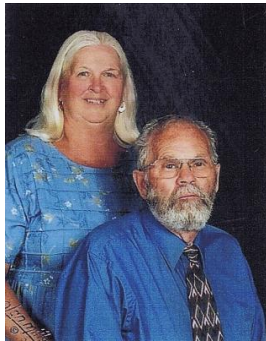
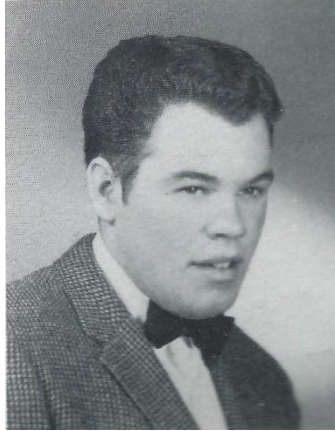


# EDWIN CHARLES CRISPELL
