ELMIRA—Thomas H. Gorman, 72, of Homewood Ave., Elmira, formerly of Trumansburg, died Wednesday, March 17, 1993, in Lake Placid, Fla.

Tom was born April 3, 1920 in Palermo, NY, a son of the late James and Marie Brown Gorman. His early schooling took place in Ithaca, NY, followed by attendance at Oswego State Teachers College. He interrupted his education to serve with the U.S. Army 68th Tank Battalion in Europe during WWII. After his graduation from Oswego, Tom taught school at the Ithaca High School until his retirement in 1978. He was a communicant of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Elmira.

He was predeceased by a daughter, Cathy Dee Huntington, who died August 1, 1992. He is survived by his wife, Beverly K. Gorman of Elmira, a daughter Mary Jane Gorman of Concord, CA, two grandchildren, a brother James Gorman of Ithaca, several nieces and nephews.
