

LILLY D. REICHMANN

Lilly D. Reichmann of 217 Willard Way, died Monday, July 14, 1997 at home. She was the widow of Professor Emeritus Felix Reichmann. She was born in Vienna, Austria, the daughter of the late Ludwig and Irene W. Doerfler.

Educated in Austria and England, she came to Ithaca in 1947 and has lived here ever since. In the early fifties she worked as a Research Associate at the School of Industrial and Labor Relations (Cornell). In 1958 she received a Master's Degree in History from Cornell University and from 1959 to 1977 taught History of Western Civilization at Ithaca Senior High School. After her retirement, she taught E.S.L. English as a second lang to foreign students at Cornell from 1978 to 1985 and again from 1988 to 1994.

She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in. Ithaca, Senior Citizens Council and Historic Ithaca.

She is survived by her daughter Ingrid H. Matheson of New York City: her brother, John T. Doerfler of Havertown, PA.; several nieces and nephews; and many kind Ithaca friends.
